Snow Dough Craft

Supplies needed:

- Cornstarch
- Lotion
- Iridescent glitter (optional)
- Snowflake cookie cutter(optional)









Snow Dough Instructions:

Step 1: Add 1 cup of cornstarch to a large mixing bowl.

Step 2: Then add ½ cup of lotion (baby lotion or body lotion) to the cornstarch and mix until combined. You want the dough to be formed into a ball and not sticky before removing from the bowl.

Step 3: Next, take out the dough and place it on some wax paper. Knead with your hands. Keep kneading until it forms a dough-like consistency. If it's still too sticky add another tablespoon of cornstarch. Keep kneading until it is no longer sticky and is soft.

Step 4: Sprinkle some glitter on (optional) and knead in.

Step 5: Once your dough is finished, use snowflake cookie cutters and rolling pins to play with it!

<u>Storage:</u> Keep the playdough in plastic wrap and store in an airtight container to help it last longer. If the dough dries out, add a few extra squirts of lotion to it and knead back in.

Protect Yourself and Others From Becoming Sick This Winter:

The CDC says that handwashing is an important step to staying healthy year-round, especially in the winter when illness is much more rapidly spread. It is recommended to use soap and water every time you wash your hands.

• Infants (0-12 months):

Wet your **hands** with clean, running water (warm or cold). Make sure the water isn't too hot for little **hands**. Use soap and lather up for about 20 seconds. Antibacterial soap isn't a must — any soap will do.

Toddlers (1-3 years):

Teach kids the five easy steps for handwashing —wet, lather, scrub, rinse and dry—and the key times to wash hands, such as after using the bathroom or before eating. You can find ways to make it fun, like making up your own handwashing song or turning it into a game.

Preschoolers (3-5 years):

Build it into your child's routine. Before every snack and meal, announce that it's time to wash your hands. Make it accessible. Provide a step stool next to the sink, so your child can reach the faucet.
